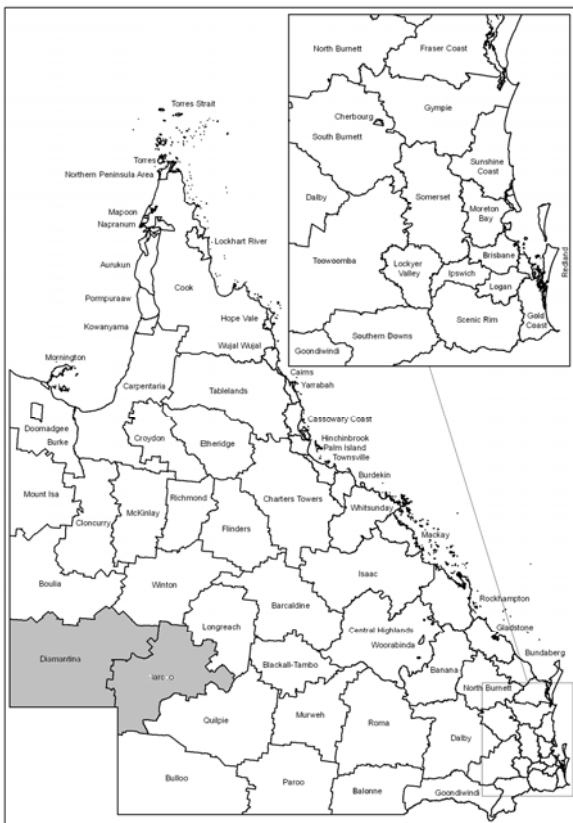


## Disaster Event –South West Queensland Flooding June 2008



### Event Timing and Location –

Storm activity around the Queen’s Birthday Weekend 7-9 June caused localised flooding in South Western Queensland areas. As a result of the flooding, significant damage has been reported in two shires to date.

### Assistance Activated –

The Acting Minister for Emergency Services activated the Commonwealth/State Natural Disaster Relief and Recovery Arrangements (NDRRA).

- Restoration of Essential Public Assets;
