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This detailed locality map illustrates the geological and topographical features of the Forsayth area. Key elements include:

- Rivers:** Gilbert River, Robertson River, Agate Creek, Little Robertson Creek, and Cleva Creek.
- Mountains and Ranges:** Marquis Hill, Long Gully HS, Numerous Old Mine Shafts, The Castle, Victory Peak, Mt Flat Top, Mt Heycock Range, Mt Helpman, Mt Spinifex, and Robin Hood HS.
- Geological Features:** Green Hills HS 5km, Georgetown 25km, and Einasleigh 66km.
- Mining History:** Numerous old mine shafts, Marquis Hill Landing Ground, and the location of the 11, 26, 31, 39, 51, 63, and 70 shafts.
- Infrastructure:** Major roads marked with route numbers 11, 26, 31, 39, 51, 63, and 70.
- Settlements:** North Head HS, South Head HS, and Forsayth.
